RE: Using a US Club Soccer passcard in a non-US Club Soccer-sanctioned league

US Club Soccer's policy for playing with a US Club Soccer passcard in a league not sanctioned by US Club Soccer has not changed. As a reminder, the policy is as follows:

- Pursuant to U.S. Soccer Federation and US Club Soccer bylaws, US Club Soccer passcards and rosters <u>may not be</u> <u>used</u> to participate in a state association- or other U.S. Soccer organization-sanctioned league that is not sanctioned by US Club Soccer.
- Players and clubs are free to participate in other leagues and programs (provided they abide by all of the US Club Soccer league's scheduling and other requirements), but players and staff must obtain passcards from the U.S. Soccer-affiliated organization that sanctions that league. US Club Soccer liability and accident insurance will not be in effect for the club or players should such participation occur.
- Moreover, a club's US Club Soccer membership/registration may be affected, and other sanctions may be imposed against the club or it coaches for violation of this policy.
- This policy does not apply to US Club Soccer members participating in an unrestricted tournament sanctioned by another U.S. Soccer organization. In these cases, US Club Soccer passcards and rosters may always be used, and US Club Soccer's insurance is in effect.
